WHEREAS, Section 22.22.085 of the Municipal Code of the City of Santa Barbara grants the Historic Landmarks Commission the authority designate as a Structure of Merit any structure, natural feature, site or area having historic, architectural, archaeological, cultural or aesthetic significance;

WHEREAS, the legal property owner of 413 Wyola Road, Santa Barbara, CA is John Mardiat;

WHEREAS, the legal description of the property is attached as Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, historic research found that the simple interpretation of the Spanish Colonial Revival style house constructed 1924 may qualify for possible historic designation under City of Santa Barbara Master Environmental Assessment criteria as evidenced in the historic resource significance report;

WHEREAS, the historic significance form found house constructed in 1924 in a simple interpretation of the Spanish Colonial Revival style is significant for its historical and architectural influence on the heritage of the City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Municipal Code Section 22.22.035.(d)(2), the permit request of a possibly historic structure shall be scheduled at the Historic Landmarks Commission for a hearing on the application concurrently with a duly noticed hearing to allow the Commission to decide among the following options: 1) Listing on the Potential Historic Resources List, 2) Structure of Merit designation, or 3) City Landmark designation.

WHEREAS, the Historic Landmarks Commission held a public hearing on April 28, 2021, during which hearing comments were invited on the proposed Structure of Merit designation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HISTORIC LANDMARKS COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SANTA BARBARA THAT:

SECTION 1. The cottage, constructed in 1924 in a simple interpretation of the Spanish Colonial Revival style at 413 Wyola Road, Santa Barbara, CA, APN 021-103-005, is designated as a City of Santa Barbara Structure of Merit.

SECTION 2. The City Structure of Merit designation boundary includes the entire parcel.

SECTION 3. The Historic Landmarks Commission finds that the subject property meets the following Structure of Merit criteria (A through K) listed in section 22.22.040 of the Municipal Code:

- A. Its character, interest or value as a significant part of the heritage of the City, the State or the Nation;
- D. Its exemplification of a particular architectural style or way of life important to the City, the State or the Nation; and
- G. Criterion G. Its embodiment of elements demonstrating outstanding attention to architectural design, detail, materials or craftsmanship.
