COMMITTEE AND STAFF COMMUNICATIONS:

A. Approval of Minutes:

A motion was made and seconded (LaBonte/Saltzman) to approve the amended minutes of April 10, 2017. The motion passed (3/0).

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Programmatic Exemption request for use of Sulfuryl Floride, Chloropicrin at City Facilities – For Action

Scott from Lenz Pest Control described three options for dealing with termites at various City facilities (Central and Eastside Libraries, Fire Station #3, Surveyors Building, MacKenzie Recreation Building):

1. Injection – localized treatment
2. Heat treatment
3. Tent fumigation

Of these three options, fumigation is the only way to treat all of the termites. Some areas are inaccessible for borade use, and heat treatment may not reach all areas, including walls. Tenting fumigation would penetrate the walls. Additionally, if the tenting option were approved, Lenz would complete the following: 1. hire security to keep people out of buildings; 2. monitor during the days tented; 3. fence the perimeter (including possibly closing the bus stop on Anacapa St.) if necessary; and 4. post signs in advance and after monitoring is complete.

A motion was made and seconded (LaBonte/Saltzman) to approve the tent fumigation, where necessary, of the proposed City facilities with the four conditions mentioned above. The motion passed unanimously (3/0).
