SUBJECT: Environmental Services' Clean SB Program

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Neighborhood Advisory Council receive a presentation regarding the Clean SB Program, covering a variety of clean-up efforts throughout the city.

DISCUSSION:

In 2018, the Environmental Services Division introduced an enhanced suite of clean-up programming known as the Clean SB program. Included under this umbrella are litter clean-up programs and events, abandoned waste/bulky item collection, public container maintenance, homeless encampment clean-ups, code enforcement (as related to clean-up programs), and a forthcoming abandoned shopping cart program.

The purpose of the program is to take a more comprehensive approach to trash and related blight issues in order to increase response time and proactively work towards solutions. In the last two years, Environmental Services staff has added clean-up programs, run pilot projects, utilized technology, and increased data collection to effectively respond to the growing clean-up needs.

The presentation will provide more detail on these programs, including information on volunteer clean-up programs, the Annual City Clean-up, and related opportunities.
