### **2. Subject: City of Santa Barbara Strategic Energy Plan**

Recommendation: That the Neighborhood Advisory Council:

- A. Receive a presentation from staff regarding the City of Santa Barbara's Strategic Energy Plan Draft; and
- B. Receive a brief update on the City's lighting projects.

Summary: The presentation covered the development and preliminary findings of the City's Strategic Energy Plan, which will guide the City's work to achieve 100 percent renewable electricity by 2030. The presentation also provided an update on the City's various lighting projects, including the conversion of streetlights to Light Emitting Diode (LED) lamps.
