Comments: The Committee and staff determined that the tree was healthy, and had a beautiful canopy. The Committee did not feel that this tree represented a significant visual impediment to vehicles exiting the driveway and that the extent of hardscape damage to the driveway did not warrant removal of the tree. Staff performed an inspection of garage and found that cracks in the concrete slab were not related to tree roots. The Committee and staff recommend that this tree be pruned along with other oak trees on San Onofre. Forestry staff will return after the canopy pruning to perform root pruning on the driveway side of the tree to reduce the likelihood of further damage to the driveway apron.
