Appointment Process and Meeting Schedule

Committee Projects/Activities

The Creeks Advisory Committee has three subcommittees that work on the following:

1. The Strategic Planning Subcommittee assists with long range planning for the Creeks Division, and assesses the purpose and functions of the Creeks Committee.

2. The Watersheds Subcommittee assists with watershed planning, determines strategies and resource needs, and participates in the development of the Watershed Technical Assistance Program.
3. The Budget Subcommittee (standing) reviews and discusses the annual Creeks Program Budget proposals prior to Committee consideration and provides recommendations to the full Committee and City Council.
4. The Education/Outreach Subcommittee assists in the implementation of the Creeks Division Public Education Plan. Following the Public Opinion Survey currently taking place, members will assist in any necessary modification of the Public Education Plan.

Recommendations/Concerns

The Creeks Advisory Committee is currently short one member. City Council is expected to appoint a new member in July 2008 to bring the Committee to seven members.
