**DISCUSSION:** Santa Barbara Golf Club opened for golf play on January 12, 1958; making "Muni", as it is still affectionately called, 50 years old in 2008. To commemorate this very special milestone, a committee was formed to plan special events. Attached is the information flyer that will be distributed to golfers at the Pro Shop and e-mailed to golfers. All publicity started the week of May 21st.

Four specials for golfers will be held from June 1 through August 31<sup>st</sup>:

- Two at Twilight After 5 Special 9 holes of golf for two golfers and a special dinner at Mulligans

- Lucky Birthday Bonus golfers born in 1958 get a free resident discount purchase worth \$25 (allows golfer access to resident rates)
