SUBJECT: Police Activities League Presentation

RECOMMENDATION: That the Commission receives a presentation from Police Activities League (PAL) on current programs and the proposed transfer of Twelve35 Teen Center operation and maintenance.

At the April 28th Parks and Recreation Commission meeting, Commissioners requested more information on the transfer of operation of the Twelve35 Teen Center to PAL, proposed in the Parks and Recreation Department Fiscal Year 2011 budget. Specifically:

- Operational structure
- Role of teens in programming, and policy
- Written plan of governance

The Commission also encouraged staff to schedule a meeting for the Youth Council to meet with PAL representatives to discuss their concerns. This meeting will be held on May 25th at 4:00 pm.

Ed Szeyller, PAL Executive Director, will provide a presentation on current PAL programming within the City of Santa Barbara, proposed operation and programming of the Twelve35 Teen Center, and comments on the Youth Council meeting with PAL
