SUBJECT: Street Tree Advisory Committee Recommendations

RECOMMENDATION: That the Commission:

A. Conditionally approve the following Setback Tree removal request.

1. 1311 San Miguel Ave. – Araucaria spp., Star Pine – Wayne Cassriel

The Committee recommends that the Commission approve the removal on the condition the tree is replaced with a Flowering Plum tree suggested on the application. The Committee determined the tree is too large for the space it is in.

B. Approve the following Setback Tree removal request.

1. 822 ½ N. Nopal St. – Pinus pinea, Italian Stone Pine – Alejandro Mendez

The Committee recommends that the Commission approve the removal. The Committee determined the space is not appropriate for a tree.

C. Approve the addition to the Street Tree Master Plan.

1. 1200 block of Coast Village Rd. – No designation - Phil Suding

The 1200 block of Coast Village Road does not have a current street tree designation. There is a project being proposed for 1255 Coast Village Road which will provide tree wells in the sidewalk for street trees. The 1200 block of Coast Village Road has small sidewalk tree wells, medium to large sized planters along the diagonal parking and large medians allowing for varying sized trees.

The Committee recommends that the Commission approve the following Street Tree designations for the 1200 block of Coast Village Road: Lagerstroemia indica 'Tuscarora', Tuscarora Crape Myrtle; Magnolia grandiflora 'Samuel Sommer', Sannuel Sommer Magnolia; Magnolia grandiflora 'Saint Mary', Saint Mary Magnolia; Eucalyptus leucoxylon, White Ironbark; Eucalyptus deglupta, Mindanao Gum; and Cupressus macrocarpa, Monterey Cypress.
