Summary of Council Actions

January

1. Council increased appropriations by \$76,037 in the Parks and Recreation Department Fiscal Year 2014 Miscellaneous Grants Fund for maintenance of Parma Park.
2. Council and the Successor Agency authorized the City Administrator and Executive Director to execute a contract between the Successor Agency and the City of Santa Barbara Parks and Recreation Department in the amount of \$27,290 for project design and management services, and approve expenditures of up to \$5,000 for City land development permits; and authorized the General Services Manager to restrict competition and issue two purchase orders for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$50,000 to International Play Equipment Manufacturers Association, certified vendors that meet the City's qualifications for playground equipment and fall surfacing.
3. Council and the Successor Agency authorized the Executive Director to execute a contract between the Successor Agency and Kruger Bensen Ziemer Architects, Inc. (KBZ), in the amount of \$921,500 for architectural and engineering design services, and construction documents, bidding, and administration; and authorized the City Administrator and the Executive Director to execute a contract between the Successor Agency and the City of Santa Barbara Parks and Recreation Department in the amount of \$51,288 for project management services, and approve expenditures of up to \$34,425 for City land development permits.
