Summary of Council Actions

April 21 – May 19, 2015

1. Council increased estimated revenues and appropriations by \$33,500 in the Parks and Recreation Fiscal Year 2015 General Fund budget to reflect increased program revenues and expense; accepted a contribution from the Parks and Recreation Community (PARC) Foundation in the amount of \$100,340 for Parks and Recreation programs, including Summer Fun Drop-in Recreation, Children's Fiesta Parade, and the Culinary Partnership Program; and increased revenues and appropriations in the Fiscal Year 2015 Parks and Recreation Miscellaneous Grants Fund for Youth Activities Program by \$45,500 and the Miscellaneous Grants Fund for Neighborhood and Outreach Services by \$54,840.
2. Council authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to enter into a three-year lease agreement with the United Boys and Girls Club of Santa Barbara County for the Westside Boys and Girls Club located at 602 W. Anapamu Street, at one dollar a year.
3. Council accepted the Integrated Pest Management (IPM) 2014 Annual Report that addresses the use of pesticides and alternatives to control weeds or eliminate pests on City property.
