**4. Subject: Street Tree Advisory Committee Recommendations – For Action (Attachments)**

Recommendation: That the Commission:

**A. Deny the following Street Tree removal request:**

1. 2514 Castillo St. – *Eucalyptus nicholii*, Nichols Willow Leafed Peppermint – Blanca F. Benedict

The Committee determined that although this specie is not designated for Castillo Street the tree is in good condition and provides value to the area. The Committee (3/1/1) recommends that the Commission deny the removal.

**B. Conditionally approve the following Setback Tree removal request:**

1. 425 W. Los Olivos St. – *Morus alba*, White Mulberry Tree – James P. Carbone

The Committee (5/0) recommends that the Commission approve the removal on the condition the applicant replace with a tree that has the potential to achieve 25 feet in height. The Committee commented that there's opportunity to plant trees away from the existing trees.
