Dear City of SB tree removal dept.

To whom it may concern,

We have a cedar tree that we would like to have removed. It is parallel to an Edison power pole in our yard, and as a result of that close proximity, is dangerous.

The branches weave around the lower cable lines and have to be hacked back annually by Edison to keep the branches from entangling around the high power lines. It is not a good place for a tree. As you might expect, it also has been trimmed back radically in the past, causing parts of the tree to die and look unsightly and uneven.

There is a live Oak under the tree that is struggling to find sun. We want that tree to flourish and would like to plant another Oak nearby.

This application is **not** related to any other development. We are **not** in an Historic area and the tree is **not** associated with any designated Historic Landmark. Please see attached photo and \$50 application fee.
