

**CITY OF SANTA BARBARA
PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT**

Summary of Council Actions

November 14, 2017 through January 9, 2018

1. On November 14, 2017, Council
 - A. Accepted USS Cal Builders, Inc.'s request to withdraw the apparent low bid of \$11,800,000 for construction of the Cabrillo Pavilion Arts Center and Bathhouse Renovation Project, Bid No. 3884, in compliance with Public Contract Code section 5100 due to clerical error; and
 - B. Awarded a contract with Diani Building Corp, in their low bid amount of \$16,700,000 for construction of the Cabrillo Pavilion Arts Center and Bathhouse Renovation Project, Bid No. 3884; and authorized the Public Works Director to execute the contract and approve expenditures up to \$1,670,000 to cover any cost increases that may result from contract change orders for extra work and differences between estimated bid quantities and actual quantities measured for payment.
2. On December 12, 2017, Council authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute a professional services contract with Fairbank, Maslin, Maullin, Metz & Associates (FM3) in the amount of \$50,940 to conduct public awareness research related to creek and ocean water quality, and ongoing education and outreach efforts.
3. On December 12, 2017, Council increased appropriations and estimated revenues by \$81,575 in the Parks and Recreation Department Fiscal Year 2018 Miscellaneous Grants Fund for maintenance of Parma Park.
4. On December 12, 2017, Council adopted, by reading of title only, A Resolution of the Council of the City of Santa Barbara Relating to the Destruction of Records Held by the Parks and Recreation Department in the Administration, Parks, and Recreation Divisions.
5. On January 9, 2018, Council
 - A. Authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute a Caretaker Rental Agreement for Hilda McIntyre Ray Park with Robert Cerda, commencing January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018;
 - B. Authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute a Caretaker Rental Agreement for Franceschi Park with Luis Quesada, commencing February 1, 2018, through January 31, 2019; and

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- C. Authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute a Caretaker Rental Agreement for Skofield Park with Christopher Clark, commencing February 1, 2018, through January 31, 2019.
