**Summary of Council Actions**

**April 24, 2018 to May 15, 2018**

1. On April 24, 2018, Council accepted the Integrated Pest Management (IPM) 2017 Annual Report that addresses the use of pesticides and alternatives to control weeds or eliminate pests on City property.
2. On May 1st, 2018, Council authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute a professional services agreement with RRM Design Group in the amount of \$275,794 to develop master plans for Ortega Park and Dwight Murphy Field, and approved expenditures of up to \$27,579 to cover any additional cost that may result from necessary changes in the scope of work.
3. On May 8, 2018, Council waived compliance with formal bid procedures pursuant to Santa Barbara Municipal Code section 4.52.070(K) and authorized the sole source purchase of Norwell Outdoor Fitness equipment from Out-Fit for \$62,435.27.
4. On May 8, 2018, Council adopted by reading of title only, A Resolution of the Council of the City of Santa Barbara Amending Resolution No. 17-058; Establishing Certain City Fees, to authorize the introduction of new Parks and Recreation Fees.
5. On May 15, 2018, Council authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to enter into a ten-year lease agreement with the United Boys and Girls Club of Santa Barbara County for the Westside Boys and Girls Club, located at 602 W. Anapamu Street, at \$1 per year.
