

**CITY OF SANTA BARBARA

**Summary of Council Actions**

**February 26, 2019 to March 12, 2019**

1. On February 26, 2019, Council authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute a personal services agreement with iSurf, a California Corporation, for the provision of 2019 Youth Traveling Surf Camps, with compensation equal to 90% of the total basic fees collected for the camp and the total compensation estimated at \$50,000 based on the projected number of camp participants.
2. On February 26, 2019, Council authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute a personal services agreement with Jon Lee, an individual, for the provision of 2019 Youth Beach Volleyball Camps, with compensation equal to 65% of the total basic fees collected for the camp and the total compensation estimated at \$100,000 based on the projected number of camp participants.
3. On February 26, 2019, Council authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute a personal services agreement with North American Youth Activities (NAYA), DBA Kidz Love Soccer, a California Corporation, for the provision of 2019 Youth Soccer Programs, with compensation equal to 65% of the total basic fees collected for the camp and the total compensation estimated at \$40,000 annually based on the projected number of camp participants.
4. On February 26, 2019, Council authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute a second contract amendment with Santa Barbara County Trails Council to amend the scope of services for trail design, reports, and maps associated with the Parma Park Sustainable Trails project in the amount of \$4,576 for a total contract amount of \$39,450.
5. On March 12, 2019, the Mayor acknowledged and proclaimed March 12, 2019, as Arbor Day in the City of Santa Barbara and recognized the value that trees provide in enhancing the quality of our lives.
6. On March 12, 2019, Council adopted, by reading of title only, a Resolution of the Council of the City of Santa Barbara Approving the Application for \$500,000 in Grant Funds for the California River Parkways Grant Program for the Arroyo Burro Creek Restoration at Palermo Drive – Property Acquisition.
