

**CITY OF SANTA BARBARA
PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT**

Summary of Council Actions

June 25, 2019 to July 16, 2019

1. On June 25, 2019, Council:
 - A. Authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute annual lease agreements for office space at the Westside Neighborhood Center for the Independent Living Resource Center, UCP/Work Inc., and the United Cerebral Palsy Association of Los Angeles, Ventura, and Santa Barbara Counties; and
 - B. Authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute an annual lease agreement for office space at the Franklin Neighborhood Center for the California Rural Legal Assistance, Inc.
2. On July 16, 2019, Council denied (6/1) the appeal filed by Karen K. Blanco and upheld the Parks and Recreation Commission's decision to deny the removal of an *Araucaria heterophylla*, Norfolk Island Pine located at 2131 Red Rose Way.
3. On July 16, 2019, Council:
 - A. Adopted, by reading of title only, a Resolution of the Council of the City of Santa Barbara Authorizing the Parks and Recreation Director to Submit a Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Program Grant Application for the Bohnett Park Revitalization Project; and
 - B. Moved, if Awarded Grant Funds, to Execute a State of California Standard Agreement in an Amount Not to Exceed \$1,350,000.
4. On July 16, 2019, Council found it in the best interest of the City to waive the bidding process as provided in Municipal Code Section 4.52.080(k) and authorize the General Services Manager to issue a Purchase Order to Downstream Services, Inc. (Downstream Services) in the amount of \$44,570 for permeable paver maintenance.
