

**CITY OF SANTA BARBARA

Summary of Council Actions

July 21 through August 11, 2020

1. On July 21, 2020, Council increased estimated revenues and appropriations in the Fiscal Year 2021 Parks and Recreation Department Miscellaneous Grants Fund in the amount of \$18,000 for a donation received from the Santa Barbara County Trails Council for development of coastal interpretive signage.
2. On July 21, 2020, Council denied the appeal filed by Ms. Amy Steinfeld and upheld the Parks and Recreation Commission decision to deny the removal of one Brachychiton discolor, Queensland Lacebark Tree, located in the parkway at 1721 Gillespie Street.
3. On July 28, 2020, Council authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute a contract amendment with 805 Beach Volleyball Club, a Limited Liability Company, for the completion of 2020 Youth Beach Volleyball Camps, with compensation equal to 65% of the total basic fees collected for each camp, and the total compensation estimated at \$75,000 based on the projected number of camp participants.
4. On July 28, 2020, Council authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute a contract amendment with Shane Carmody, an Individual, for the provision of 2020 Youth Surf and Beach Camps, with compensation equal to 65% of the total basic fees collected for each camp, and the total compensation estimated at \$45,000 based on the projected number of camp participants.
5. On July 28, 2020, Council authorized the Parks and Recreation Director to execute a contract amendment with iSurf, a California Corporation, for the provision of 2020 Youth Surf and Beach Camps, with compensation equal to 90% of the total basic fees collected for each camp, and the total compensation estimated at \$78,500 based on the projected number of camp participants.
6. On August 11, 2020, Council authorized the City Administrator to execute the Memorandum of Understanding with the Community Action Commission in the amount of \$67,665 related to the City's participation in the South Coast Task Force on Youth Safety.
