**APPLICATION OF BARRY WINNICK, ARCHITECT FOR GLENNIS AND JIM MALCOLM,
1427 SHORELINE DRIVE, APN 045-185-003, E-3/SD-3 (ONE FAMILY RESIDENCE AND COASTAL
OVERLAY) ZONES, LOCAL COASTAL PLAN LAND USE DESIGNATION: LOW DENSITY
RESIDENTIAL (5 DU/AC) (MST2014-00136).**

The proposed project involves a facade remodel and 1,096 square feet of first- and second-floor additions to an existing 1,152 square-foot, two-story, single-family residence with an attached 366 square-foot two-car garage. The proposal includes conversion of the existing two-car garage into living area, a 350 square-foot first floor addition, a 379 square-foot second floor addition, construction of a new 458 square-foot, two-car carport and attached 149 square-foot storage room, the construction of a total of 901 square feet of deck/patio area, interior remodel work, and additional site work. This proposal will also address violations identified in Zoning Information Report ZIR2011-00013 and enforcement case ENF2010-00744. The proposed total of 2,855 net square feet on a 12,012 square-foot lot is 72% of the maximum floor-to-lot area ratio (FAR).

The discretionary application required for this project is a Coastal Development Permit (CDP2014-00014) to allow the proposed development in the Appealable Jurisdiction of the City's Coastal Zone (SBMC §28.44.060).

The Environmental Analyst has determined that the project is exempt from further environmental review pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15303.

You are invited to attend this hearing. Written comments are welcome and will be entered into the public record. Written information should be submitted prior to the meeting at the Planning Division Office, 630 Garden St; by mail attention Planning Commission Secretary, P.O. Box 1990, Santa Barbara, CA 93102-1990; or by email at PCSecretary@SantaBarbaraCA.gov, and received no later than 4:30 P.M. on the Monday before the Planning Commission hearing. Please submit 12 copies of any written materials over 2 pages. Written comments are accepted at and up to the time of the hearing; however, the Planning Commission may not have time to consider materials submitted after the Monday deadline.

This is the only notification you will receive for this development application. The scope of this project may be modified under further review. If you, as an aggrieved party or applicant, disagree with the decision of the Planning Commission regarding the outcome of this application, you may appeal the decision to the City Council. The appeal, accompanied by the appropriate filing fee per application, must be filed in the City Clerk's Office within ten calendar days of the Planning Commission decision. If the Planning Commission decision is appealed, and if the City Council

approves the project on appeal, then it is appealable to the California Coastal Commission under California Public Resources Code §30603(a) and SBMC §28.44.200.

If you challenge the permit approval or environmental document in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to the public hearing.
