STATUS REPORT

This meeting is being held for the Planning Commission (PC) to receive and review the revisions to the Draft 2015 Bicycle Master Plan (BMP) that were made since the October 29, 2015 joint meeting held with the Transportation and Circulation Committee (TCC).

The meeting provides an opportunity for the Planning Commission (PC) to finalize the Draft BMP. Minor editorial and word choice changes were not tracked but significant changes and additions are shown in pink font. The PC is being asked to recommend that the City Council adopt the plan in January of 2016.

NEXT STEPS

The Draft BMP is also scheduled for review at the Transportation and Circulation Committee the evening of December 10, 2015, prior to being taken to City Council for final action. Neighborhood, business, advisory body and community interests have been gathered and analyzed and have significantly shaped the Bicycle Master Plan document. The consultant team, with staff's help, has used the information gathered to design a plan that meets a majority of the public desires received through the engagement process.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Planning Commission finalize the draft BMP and recommend that the City Council adopt the plan.
