BATH STREET POCKET PARK

The purpose of the hearing was for the Planning Commission to consider recommending to City Council designation of the Bath Street Pocket Park as a neighborhood park, as defined in Santa Barbara Municipal Code Section 28.37.030, upon transfer of the properties at 631 and 633 Bath Street, that comprise the park from the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency to the City.
