APPLICATION OF ASHLEIGH SHUE, SUPERVISING CIVIL ENGINEER, CITY OF SANTA BARBARA PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, CITY RIGHT OF WAY ALONG MODOC ROAD AND LAS POSITAS ROAD, ZONES ADJACENT CITY RIGHT OF WAY INCLUDING: PARK AND RECREATION ZONE WITH COASTAL ZONE OVERLAY (P-R/SD-3), PARK AND RECREATION ZONE (P-R), ONE FAMILY RESIDENCE ZONES (A-1, E-1, E-3), ONE FAMILY RESIDENCE ZONE WITH PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (E-1/PUD), PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (PUD 2.5), TWO-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (R-2), UNINCORPORATED COUNTY LAND. The Las Positas/Modoc Road Multiuse Path Project (Project) involves design and construction of a 2.6 mile-long separated multiuse pathway for bicyclists and pedestrians

in the City right-of-way along Modoc Road from Calle de Los Amigos to Las Positas Road and along Las Positas Road from Modoc Road to Cliff Drive. The Project would provide key connections among Santa Barbara's regional Cross-town and Coastal Bike Routes, the neighborhoods adjacent to the path, Elings Park, Arroyo Burro Beach County Park, and the Douglas Family Preserve. The discretionary applications required for this project are:

1. Coastal Development Permit to allow the proposed development in the Appealable/Non-Appealable Jurisdictions of the City's Coastal Zone (SBMC §28.44.060) for a portion of the project location; and
2. Project Design Review Approval by the Architectural Board of Review (SBMC §22.68).

The Planning Commission will consider approval of the Final Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared for the project pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15074. Planning Commission will also consider approval of the Coastal Development Permit.

The order of presentation after the Chair introduces the item is as follows:

2. Presentation by Applicant (15 minutes)*.
3. Public Hearing*.
4. Additional response by Applicant/Staff (5 minutes each)*.
5. Questions and comments by the commission.
6. Commission consideration of Findings and Conditions of Approval.
7. Motion, discussion of motion, decision, and vote by the Commission.

***Time may be extended or limited by the Chair of the Planning Commission.**

Items that generate a large amount of citizen interest may be taken out of their scheduled order on the agenda as a courtesy to the public in attendance. Where there are a large number of people wishing to speak on an item, the Chairman may limit time allotted to each speaker.

WRITTEN COMMENT PROCEDURE: Written comments are welcome and will be entered into the public record.
