- January 20, 2016 The Staff Hearing Officer conditionally issued a Medical Marijuana Storefront Collective Dispensary Permit to Canopy Club, Inc. with conditions that needed to be satisfied prior to commencement of operations.
- March 17, 2016 The Planning Commission upheld the decision of the Staff Hearing Officer to issue a Medical Marijuana Storefront Collective Dispensary Permit to Canopy Club, Inc. with conditions that needed to be satisfied prior to commencement of operations.
- May 3, 2016 Mary K. Bock filed a Statement of Information for Canopy Club, Inc. with the California Secretary of State identifying Ryan S. Howe as Chief Executive Officer and Chief Financial Officer and Thomas Martin as Secretary of the Corporation.
- May 10, 2016 City Council upheld the decision of the Planning Commission to a Medical Marijuana Storefront Collective Dispensary Permit to Canopy Club, Inc. with conditions that needed to be satisfied prior to commencement of operations.
- July 29, 2016 Mary K. Bock filed a Statement of Information for Canopy Club, Inc. with the California Secretary of State identifying Ryan S. Howe as Chief Executive Officer and Chief Financial Officer and Danielle Winkler as Secretary of the Corporation.
- June 27, 2017 An application was filed with the City requesting amendments to the approved Operations Plan. One of the requested amendments to the approved Operations Plan and Application was to add four additional Management Members.
- September 22, 2017 Ryan Howe filed a Statement of Information for Canopy Club, Inc. with the California Secretary of State identifying Ryan S. Howe as Chief Executive Officer, Secretary, and Chief Financial Officer.
- November 30, 2017 The City Attorney's Office issued a Notice of Hearing and Intent to Suspend or Revoke (subsequently amended on December 5, 2017) to Alicia Journey, former attorney for Ryan Howe, the identified management member of Canopy Club, Inc. in the Storefront Collective Dispensary Permit, notifying her that a hearing would be scheduled to request the Staff Hearing Officer to suspend or revoke the Storefront Collective Dispensary Permit based on the transfer of control of the Storefront Collective Dispensary Permit.
- December 20, 2017 The Staff Hearing Officer held the required public hearing to receive evidence, take testimony, and hear public comment on the City Attorney's Notice of Hearing and Intent to Suspend or Revoke the Storefront Collective Dispensary Permit.
