ANNUAL ALLOCATION OF UNUSED OR EXPIRED NONRESIDENTIAL SMALL ADDITION SQUARE FOOTAGE (PLN2019-00147)

The Planning Commission will decide whether to allocate 15,316 square feet of unused or expired nonresidential Small Addition Floor Area from calendar year 2018 to the Small Addition category or to the Community Benefit category for future development. Unused or expired Small Additions are reallocated by Planning Commission on an annual basis per the Growth Management Program passed by Council Resolution on March 5, 2013.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has held the required public hearing on the above decision.

WHEREAS, no one appeared to speak in favor or in opposition thereto, and the following exhibit was presented for the record: Staff Report dated April 4, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Planning Commission allocated 15,316 square feet of Small Addition unused or expired nonresidential Small Addition Floor Area from calendar year 2018 to the Community Benefit category for future development.
