B. **CANCELLED: THURSDAY, DECEMBER 17, 2020 LUNCH MEETING**

IN ORDER TO PROMOTE SOCIAL DISTANCING AND PRIORITIZE THE PUBLIC'S HEALTH AND WELL-BEING, THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA ISSUED EXECUTIVE ORDER N-29-20, WHICH ALLOWS LOCAL LEGISLATIVE BODIES TO HOLD MEETINGS VIA TELECONFERENCES WHILE STILL MEETING THE STATE'S OPEN AND TRANSPARENT MEETING REQUIREMENTS. When persons are called on to speak, their microphone will be activated and they will be notified to begin speaking. Each speaker will be given a total of 2 minutes to address the Commission. Pooling of time is not allowed during general public comment. The time allotted for general public comment at the beginning of the meeting is 30 minutes. The Commission, upon majority vote, may decline to hear a speaker on the grounds that the subject matter is beyond the Commission's subject matter jurisdiction.

PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDIZED ITEMS: Members of the public wishing to speak on a matter on the agenda must "raise their hand" in the GoToWebinar platform by selecting the virtual hand icon during the presentation of that item. III. NEW ITEM**APPLICATION OF PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT, CITY OF SANTA BARBARA, OWNER OF 1100 E. CABRILLO BLVD. & 1414 PARK PLACE, APN: 017-381-001; 017-382-001, ZONE: PR/S-D-3; LAND USE DESIGNATION: PARK/OPEN SPACE; (PLN2019-00535)**

The project proposes to improve water quality and restore habitat for aquatic and avian wildlife through the replacement of the Andrée Clark Bird Refuge Lagoon weir and weir gate, removal of approximately 74 non-native trees, recontouring portions of the lagoon shoreline, recontouring the mouth of the lagoon on the beach side (adjacent to the volleyball courts), seasonal lowering of the sand berm at the mouth of the lagoon on the beach side, and installation of native plants and rock clusters along the margin of the lake, islands and mouth of the lagoon. Construction of a bio-retention basin would also occur at the Municipal Tennis Center property, located at 1414 Park Place. The project requires adoption of the Final Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared for the project, and a recommendation from the Planning Commission to allow the project to proceed to the California Coastal Commission for a Consolidated Coastal Development Permit due to its location in both the Appealable Jurisdiction of the City's Coastal Zone and the California Coastal Commission Permit Jurisdiction (SBMC §28.44.060 and California Coastal Act Section 30601.3).

IV. CONTINUED ITEM: FROM DECEMBER 3, 2020**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE HISTORIC RESOURCE ORDINANCE**

Proposed amendments to the Historic Resources Ordinance which would update the Ordinance with language consistent with State and National historic preservation standards, streamline the review process, outline a process and criteria for designating historic districts, and establish buffer areas. The proposed amendments to the Historic Resources Ordinance will be incorporated into Title 30 of the Santa Barbara Municipal Code as Chapters, 30.57, 30.157 30.237 and Sections 30.220.020 and 30.300.080 "H", and the Landmark and Historic District maps will be incorporated into the Official Zoning Map. Additional related Municipal Code amendments, including adding Chapter 28.100 and deleting Chapter 22.22, are also required to implement this change. The legislative actions required are: Zoning Ordinance Amendments for Title 30 (Inland Zoning Ordinance) and Title 28 (Coastal Zoning Ordinance) changes, Amendments to Title 22 (Environmental Policy and Construction) and related Titles of the Santa Barbara Municipal Code, Zoning Map Amendments, and an Amendment to the certified Local Coastal Program Implementation Plan (SBMC §28.44.250.D). The Amendments require a recommendation from the Planning Commission to the City Council. All drafts of the Historic Resource Amendments are available at SantaBarbaraCA.gov/HROAmendments.
