Old BUSINESS

1. **Revise Dual Member Rule – For Action**

Existing Rule D.7

A dual permit allows a permit holder to sell in either the Arts or Crafts Section. Only art may be displayed and sold in the Arts Section. In the Crafts Section approximately half the items on display must be crafts. A dual permit holder may be assigned to one section or the other at any time. Transfer to the other section will occur when space becomes available. There are ten (10) dual permits available in the Crafts Section and ten (10) in the Arts Section. Dual permit holders must show a minimum of six (6) times in each section within their permit year, to retain their dual permit status. 12/2000

Proposed Rule D.7

Only art may be displayed and sold in the Arts Section, and any combination of arts and/or crafts can be displayed and sold in the Craft Section if you have a dual permit. A dual permit holder may be assigned to one section or the other at any time. Transfer to the other section will occur when space becomes available and assigned at a space assignment meeting.

Brad Kazmerzak – Stated that these changes are in an effort to simplify and clarify the rule for a better understanding. Existing rules are too complicated and binding.

Margaret Landreau – No problem with changing the rule however; do not like that Art can only be displayed in Art section and anything can be displayed in Crafts section.

William Smariga – Rule seems very biased. Both sections should be able to show in spots available.

Public Comment:

Tanda Jacobs – This rule changes the entire show. Do not agree to change this rule at this time. Rules should not be changed during this pandemic.

Marilyn Loperfido – This is only for administrative purposes to trim down the rule. Not a discussion regarding who shows in what section.

Marilyn Dannenhower – Craft people are unhappy about rules that limit crafts from being in the art section. Seems like a new rule.

Margaret Landreau – This rule has not been enforced, does not make sense. More than half the show are in the crafts section.

Peggy Buchanan – Motion to accept revision; **Brad Kazmerzak** to second. **William Smariga** – No. **Margaret Dannehower** –No.

Motion failed– rule to remain the same as written.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Review Show Reopening – For Discussion

Jason Bryan – less than 50 percent of members are showing at this time. Spaces pre-reserved on sign-up-genius. Six foot setbacks from sidewalk observed, face masks, social distancing. Additional signage will be provided to inform the public of the rules.

Public Comment:

Marilyn Loperfido – Very dangerous for members to be showing at this time. Even with restrictions, very high risk.

Marilyn Dannehower – If someone refuses to wear a mask, what can we do in that instance?

Jason Bryan – Masks are required, members encouraged not to show if uncomfortable.

Margaret Landreau – Members can refuse to sell to public who are not wearing masks.

2. Review Restrictions Placed on Cottage Food Members – For Discussion

Brad Kazmerzak – Should not be any restrictions at this time.

Margaret Landreau – Should this be addressed at this time? Keep it at eight vendors?

Peggy Buchanan – Let's see how this goes for the future of the show. No changes at this time.

William Smariga – Allow Cottage Food Members an opportunity to make some money.

Public Comment:

Marilyn Loperfido – Cottage Food Members are vendors not members.

Clair Weber – Cottage food members are purveyors not vendors.

Margaret Landreau – Continue this item to when full show reopens.

3. Review Request for Show Integration – For Discussion

Jason Bryan - City Attorney received a petition in May 2019 regarding Show Integration –this is formal acknowledgement of receipt of that petition– investigation ongoing at this time, will review outcome at a later date with Committee.

Brad Kazmerzak – I also sent a letter, would like this letter included in this investigation so both sides are represented. Opposing argument to Marilyn's letter was not considered. All decisions should be tabled until pandemic is over.

Public Comment:

Tanda Jacobs – Not the time to make changes. Contentious issue. Would like to see Brads letter.

Marilyn Dannehower - Members love the show. Needs to be one show.

Jeff Kennedy – City Attorney found some points valid and worth looking into? What were those points?

Rich Hanna – Items contained in petition relate to rules and regulations, Parks and Recreation Director has authority– per Municipal Code Section 15.08.070 - Parks and Recreation Director does have the ability to promulgate rules and regulations for the administration of the Arts and Crafts show. This requires input from the Arts and Craft show members, however, she may not be bound by them. Because petition was sent direct to the City Attorney this required Municipal Code research as it may require a rules and regulation change. Moving forward, and in an effort to be transparent, these are the issues being researched and studied.
