OLD BUSINESS

- a. During discussion it was determined that this date was close to the beginning of the school year. Youth Council Member Nathaniel Getachew requested an amended to the date. It was moved and seconded to amend the date to October 8, 2016, with the time to be determined. Motion carried unanimously.*
- b. Town Hall Meeting w/CADA** – Members of the Youth Council spoke about the event which had about 180 participants. Youth Council members stated it was a good event and moving at times and presented a great opportunity for teens to discuss with adults the issues with underage drinking.
- c. SCTC Event** – Members who attended the Teen Summit in South Gate, California spoke about the event. All agreed it was a worthwhile trip stating that they met and networked with lots of other teen leaders. Members felt that the Youth Council's presentation on bullying was well received by the teens that were present. Youth Council stated they got lots of new followers on Instagram

- a. Youth Council Budget & Fundraising** – Chair Voulgaris and Treasurer Trosky spoke about the need for the Youth Council to have funding for their events. Members discussed that they did want to increase in their fundraising efforts but also wanted to see if the City Council would consider providing them with a small budget.
