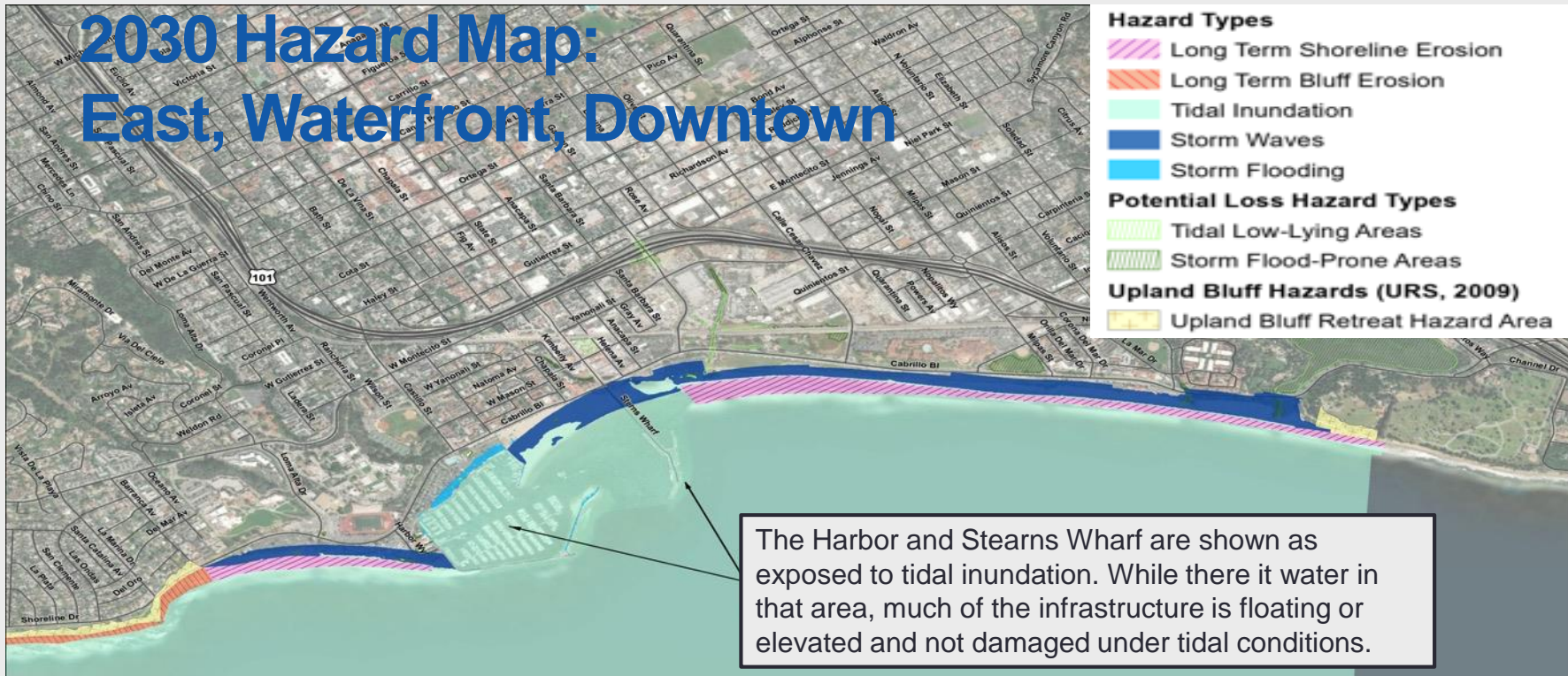

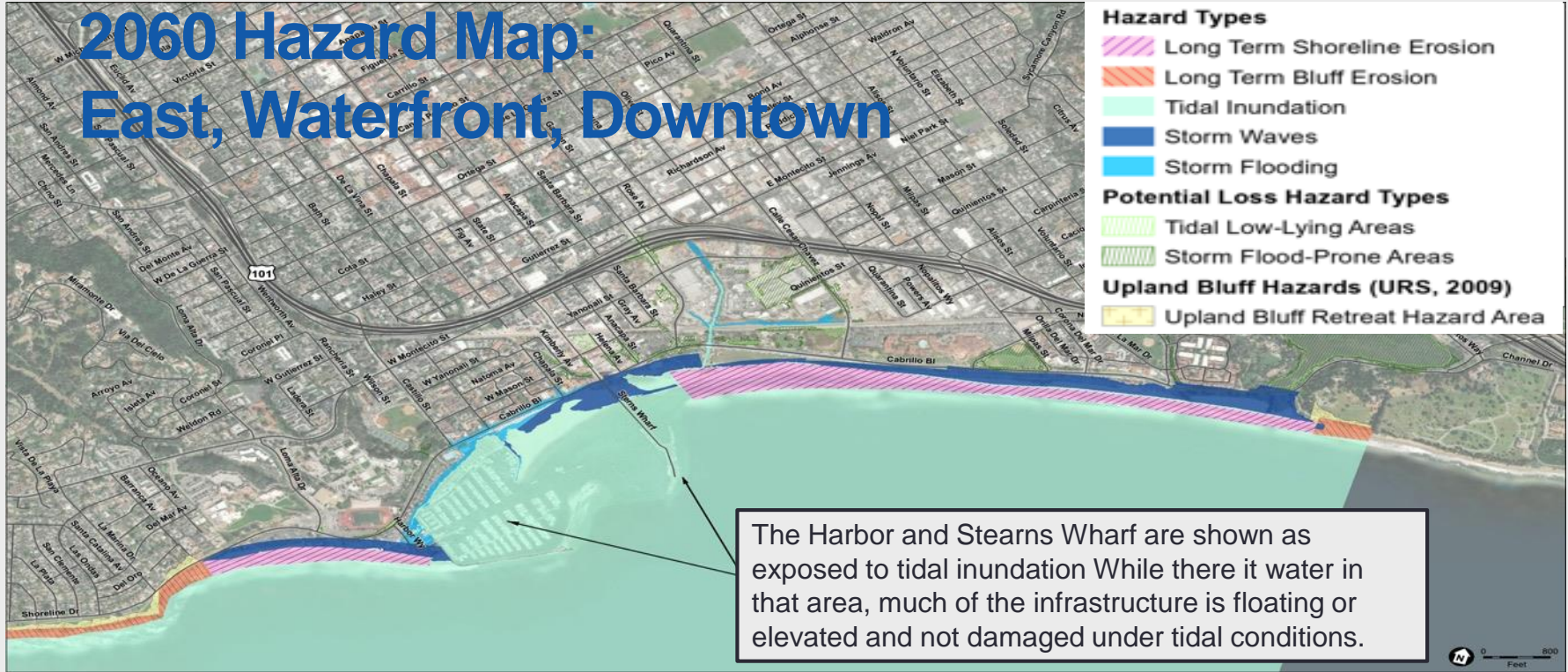

2060 Hazard Map: East, Waterfront, Downtown

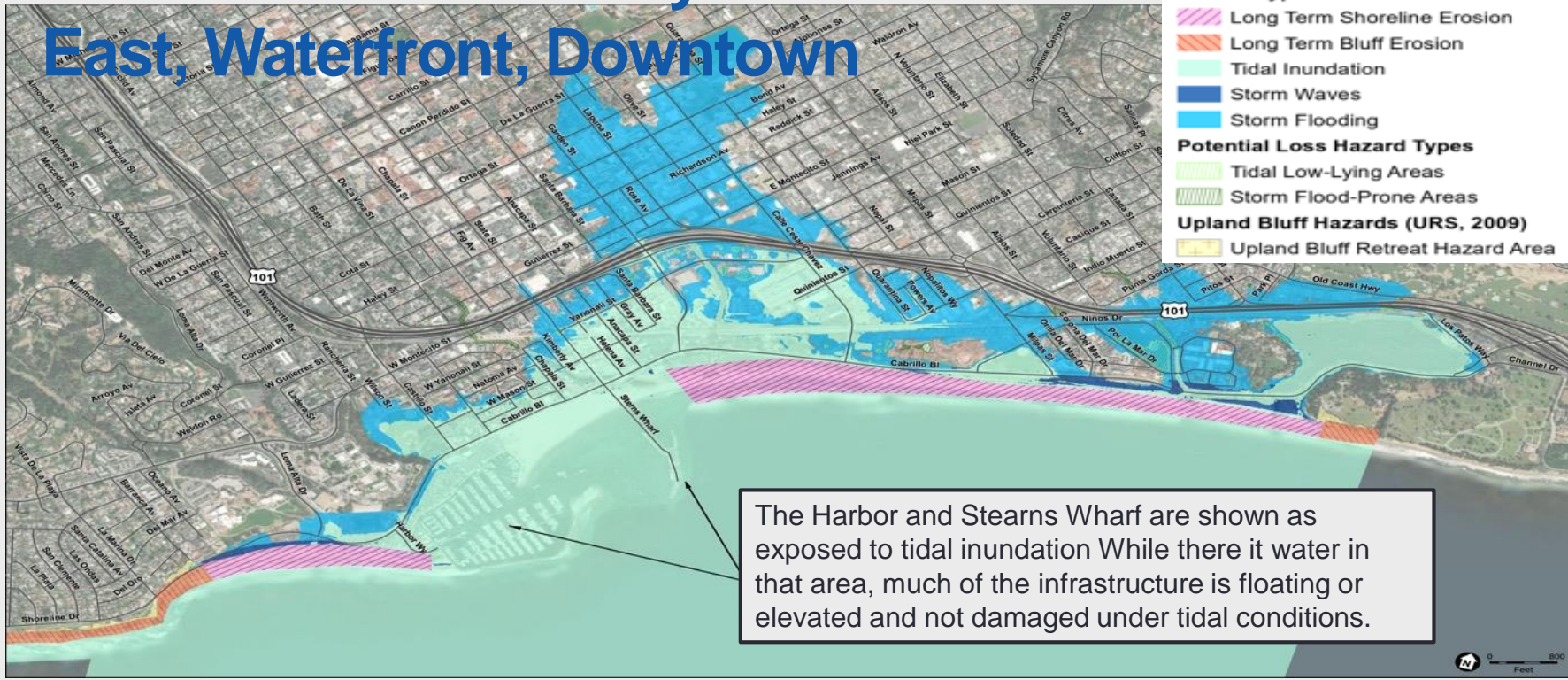
