(Proposal for a new sign program for the Santa Barbara Museum of Art. The applicant is requesting three exceptions to the ordinance requirement including signage in excess of allowable, to allow vertical lettering, to allow pole signage, and to allow banner/hanging style signs for exhibit template signage. The linear building frontage is 220 feet. The allowable signage is 90 square feet.)

 - a) There are exceptional or extraordinary circumstances or conditions applicable to the property involved, or to the intended use of the property, that do not generally apply to other properties in the vicinity.
 - b) The granting of the exception will not be materially detrimental to the public welfare or injurious to the properties or improvements in the vicinity.
 - c) The proposed signage is in conformance with the purpose and intent of the Sign Ordinance as stated in Santa Barbara Municipal Code Section 22.70.010.B.
