The Committee acknowledged a letter of concern from Virginia Rehling regarding potential lighting impacts of signage lighting on El Pueblo Viejo.

1. The Sign Committee can approve a painted vertical sign in this location, recognizing that the business façade is obscured by traffic lights and poles at the street corner.
2. The applicant is advised to further study illumination of the signage; the Committee suggested small LED spotlights to be installed in inconspicuous locations in the wrought iron balconies above.
