The Single Family Design Board (SFDB) will hold a public hearing to give the public an opportunity to be heard and offer comments early in the review process on architectural design related issues or development plan approval findings regarding the subject property below:

Project Description: **Proposal to permit the "as-built" replacement of an existing 74 linear foot six-**

foot tall wood fence located within required front setback and the right-of-way along La Jolla Circle, and to relocate an "as-built" 64 linear foot 3.5-foot tall wood fence located in the right-of-way along Medcliff Road. The parcel is currently developed with an existing one-story single-family residence. The improvements will address the enforcement issues identified in ENF2011-00086. The project requires Staff Hearing Officer review for a requested zoning modification to allow a portion of the existing "as-built" fence to exceed 3.5 feet in height within the required setback. This proposal also requires an encroachment permit from the Public Works Department to allow the construction of the fences to be located within the public right-of-way.

Public comments will be allowed during review of the project by the SFDB. The SFDB is a body appointed by the City Council to focus on neighborhood compatibility, aesthetics, and design issues. Comments on private views and privacy issues are only partially within the SFDB's authority. Due to time constraints, individual comments may be limited to two minutes. Written comments are also welcome up to the time of the hearing, and should be addressed to the City Planning Division, P.O. Box 1990, Santa Barbara, CA 93102-1990, or by e-mail to SFDBSecretary@SantaBarbaraCA.gov.

The scope of this project may be modified under further review. Appeals must be in writing and must be filed with the City Clerk at City Hall within 10 calendar days of the meeting at which the Board took action or rendered its decision.
