The Single Family Design Board (SFDB) will hold a public hearing to give the public an opportunity to be heard and offer comments early in the review process on architectural design related issues regarding the subject property below:

Project Description: **Proposal to demolish 16 square feet of an existing 1,292 square foot single-family residence and all of an existing 331 square foot detached garage. The proposal will add 1,486 square feet of the existing residence, of which 208 square feet will be to the existing 77 square foot basement, and also includes a new 419 square foot attached two-car garage. Also proposed are a new CMU equipment enclosure, new CMU retaining walls, new fencing, a new trash enclosure, a new swimming pool with a new pool deck, 244 cubic yards of cut-and-fill grading outside of the building footprint, and restoration of a historic sandstone cap and pier wall on the property. The project will address violations identified in a Zoning Information Report (ZIR2014-00443). The proposed total of 3,181 square feet of development on a 10,690 square foot lot in the Hillside Design District is 83% of the required guideline maximum floor-to-lot area ratio (FAR). An Administrative Exception is requested to allow a fence/wall to exceed 3-1/2 feet in height within 10 feet of the front lot line. In addition, Staff Hearing Officer review is requested for zoning modifications for additions and alterations to the dwelling for the garage, swimming pool, and pool equipment within required front setbacks.**

Public comments will be allowed during review of the project by the SFDB. The SFDB is a body appointed by the City Council to focus on neighborhood compatibility, aesthetics, and design issues. Comments on private views and privacy issues are only partially within the SFDB's authority. Due to time constraints, individual comments may be limited to two minutes. Written comments are also welcome up to the time of the hearing, and should be addressed to the City Planning Division, P.O. Box 1990, Santa Barbara, CA 93102-1990, or by e-mail to SFDBSecretary@SantaBarbaraCA.gov.

This hearing is for design review only. If the project requires approval by the Planning Commission or the Staff Hearing Officer, you will receive a notice for that public hearing. The scope of this project may be modified under further review. Other methods to be informed of future scheduled hearings for a particular project or property include:

- a. Submit a request in writing to become an "Interested Party" for future notification purposes related to the development application so the City can mail or e-mail you future SFDB agendas when the particular project is scheduled on a future agenda. This type of notification is done as a courtesy and does not require 10 day advance notice.
- b. Join the City's SantaBarbaraCA.gov/MySB where sign up information can be found. This system allows you to manage subscriptions to City email lists that cover a wide range of City topics and services, including agendas sent for all Design Review meetings. Since all agendas would be sent, users of this service would need to check each agenda for their particular project of interest.

Decisions of the SFDB may be appealed to the City Council. For further information on appeals, contact Planning Division Staff or the City Clerk's Office. Appeals must be in writing and must be filed with the City Clerk at City Hall within 10 calendar days of the meeting at which the Board took action or rendered its decision.
