PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Proposal to demolish an existing 586 square foot residence with an attached 296 square foot garage, and construct a new 2,077 square foot two-story single family residence with attached 400 square foot two-car garage and an attached 591 square foot accessory dwelling unit (ADU under separate permit). The proposed 2,477 square feet of development on a 7,209 square foot lot is 84% of the maximum allowable floor to lot area ratio (FAR).
