**APPLICATION OF THOMAS MOORE, ARCHITECT FOR CAMERON PORTER, 1720 SAN  
ANDRES STREET, APN 043-191-015, R-3 MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENCE ZONE, GENERAL PLAN  
DESIGNATION: 12 UNITS PER ACRE (MST2008-00066).**

The 5,040 square foot project site is currently developed with a single-family residence, a one-car garage, and a 75 square foot shed. The proposed project involves the construction of a new 802 square foot two-bedroom residential unit above a new 460 square foot, two-car garage and 160 square foot attached storage room. The proposal also includes a 63 square foot first floor addition to the existing 558 square foot one-story, two-bedroom residential unit and the demolition of an existing 250 square foot, legal non-conforming, single-car garage and a 75 square foot shed. A total of four parking spaces (two covered and two uncovered) will be provided on site.

The discretionary application required for this project is a Modification to provide less than the required 15 foot minimum dimension for the common open yard area and to provide the common open yard area in the front yard. (SBMC §28.21.081).

The Environmental Analyst has determined that the project is exempt from further environmental review pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Guidelines Sections 15303 & 15305.

You are invited to attend this hearing and address your verbal comments to the Staff Hearing Officer. Written comments are also welcome up to the time of the hearing, and should be addressed to the Staff Hearing Officer Secretary, P.O. Box 1990, Santa Barbara, CA 93102-1990. This is the only notification you will receive for this development application. The scope of this project may be modified under further review. If you, as an aggrieved party or applicant, disagree with the decision of the Staff Hearing Officer regarding the outcome of this application, you may appeal the decision to the Planning Commission. The appeal, accompanied by the appropriate filing fee per application, must be filed at the Planning & Zoning Counter within ten calendar days of the Staff Hearing Officer's decision.

If you challenge the permit approval or environmental document in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Staff Hearing Officer at, or prior to the public hearing.
