### RESOLUTION NO. 030-13 1727 CALLE BOCA DEL CANON MODIFICATION MAY 15, 2013

**APPLICATION OF NL DESIGN STUDIO, DESIGNER FOR DAVIS HAYDEN,  
1727 CALLE BOCA DEL CANON, APN 041-052-064, R-1 ONE-FAMILY RESIDENCE ZONE,  
GENERAL PLAN DESIGNATION: LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL (5 UNITS/AC)  
(MST2013-00155)**

The 6,560 square-foot site is currently developed with a 1,313 square foot, two-story residence with an attached garage and a carport. The proposal includes the construction of a 120 square-foot addition within the existing footprint of the residence.

The discretionary applications required for this project is a Modification to allow the second floor to encroach into the required 20-foot front setback for upper stories (SBMC § 28.15.060 and SBMC § 28.92.110).

The Environmental Analyst has determined that the project is exempt from further environmental review pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15301 and 15305 (Existing Facilities and Minor Land Use Limitations).

**WHEREAS**, the Staff Hearing Officer has held the required public hearing on the above application, and the Applicant was present.

**WHEREAS**, no one appeared to speak either in favor or in opposition of the application thereto, and the following exhibits were presented for the record:

Approved the subject application making the findings and determinations that the front setback Modification is consistent with the purposes and intent of the Zoning Ordinance and is necessary to secure an appropriate improvement on the lot. The proposed second story addition is an appropriate improvement to a single-family residence because it will not increase the building volume, footprint, or change the exterior of the building.
