**APPLICATION OF ADELE GOGGIA, AGENT FOR WILLIAM AND SHARON RICH, 2126 RIDGE LANE,
APN 019-161-006, A-2, ONE-FAMILY RESIDENCE ZONE, GENERAL PLAN DESIGNATION:LOW DENSITY
RESIDENTIAL (MAX 2 DU/ACRE) (MST2017-00201)**

The 15,046 square foot project site is currently developed with a two-story, 2,211 square foot single-family dwelling and an attached 643 square foot two-car garage. The proposed project consists of a new 395 square foot accessory building to be located in the remaining front yard, and four new window openings on the eastern façade of the dwelling. The proposed total of 3,249 square feet is 75% of the maximum allowable floor-to-lot-area ratio.

The discretionary applications required for this project are:

1. Modification to allow an accessory building to be located in the remaining front yard (SBMC §28.87.160.B and SBMC §28.92.110) and;
2. Interior Setback Modification to allow new window openings within the eastern interior setback (SBMC §28.15.060 and (SBMC §28.92.110). The project requires an environmental finding pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15183.

You are invited to attend this hearing and address your comments to the Staff Hearing Officer. Due to time constraints, individual comments are typically limited to two minutes. Please note that the Staff Hearing Officer may not have time to consider written comments received after 4:30 p.m. on the day before the meeting.

The appeal, accompanied by the appropriate filing fee per application, must be filed at the Planning & Zoning counter at 630 Garden Street within ten calendar days of the Staff Hearing Officer's decision.

If you challenge the permit approval or environmental document in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Staff Hearing Officer at or prior to the public hearing.
