**APPLICATION OF NOAH GREER, APPLICANT FOR DWELLEY- LANDRU FAMILY TRUST, 2932 CLIFF DRIVE, APN 047-091-022, A-1/SD-3 ZONES, LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM AND LAND USE PLAN DESIGNATION: RESIDENTIAL, 1 UNIT PER ACRE (MST2017-00735)**

The project includes the conversion of an existing 456 square foot detached accessory space (located above the detached garage) into a new Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) pursuant to California Government Code §65852.2. The project includes adding one new exterior window, and interior alterations to include addition of a new kitchen and adding a shower within the existing half-bathroom. The site is developed with an existing, two-story, single-family residence, and a two-story detached garage/accessory building. No alterations are proposed to the existing residence and garage.

The 1.22 acre project site is located within the Non-Appealable Jurisdiction of the City's Coastal Zone and because the proposed ADU is detached, a Coastal Development Permit is required per Coastal Commission Memorandum dated April 18, 2017 (New Accessory Dwelling Unit Legislation).

The discretionary application required for this project is a Coastal Development Permit (CDP2017-00010) to allow a detached accessory dwelling unit located in the Non-Appealable Jurisdiction of the City's Coastal Zone (SBMC §28.45.009).

Pursuant to SBMC 28.44.110, when a proposed development only involves the addition of a secondary dwelling unit to an existing single-family residence, the application shall be reviewed by the Staff Hearing Officer without a public hearing in accordance with subdivision (j) of Government Code Section 65852.2. The Staff Hearing Officer shall not issue a decision on the application until at least ten (10) calendar days after notice has been provided. The Staff Hearing Officer may receive and consider written comments from the public, but without a public hearing. The decision will be the final action of the City. The Environmental Analyst has determined that the project is exempt from further environmental review pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15303, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures.

You are invited to attend this hearing and submit your written comments to the Staff Hearing Officer in advance of the hearing. Written comments are welcome. Mail to SHO Secretary, P.O. Please note that the Staff Hearing Officer may not have time to consider written comments received after 4:30 p.m. on the Monday before the meeting.

If you challenge the permit approval or environmental document in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Staff Hearing Officer at or prior to the public hearing.
