APPLICATION OF BRETT ETTINGER, ARCHITECT FOR JASON MOCHI, 1207 DEL MAR AVENUE, APN 045-213-005, E-3/SD-3 (SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL/COASTAL) ZONES, GENERAL PLAN AND LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM LAND USE PLAN DESIGNATION: LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL, 5 DU PER ACRE (MST2018-00224 AND CDP2018-00008)

The project consists of a proposal to convert an existing 371 square foot two-garage to an Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) pursuant to California Government Code §65852.2. The 6,604 square foot lot is also developed with a 2,492 square foot two story residence. Two tandem parking spaces are proposed within the existing driveway. The project site is located within the Non-Appealable Jurisdiction of the City's Coastal Zone and because the proposed Accessory Dwelling Unit is detached from the main residence, a Coastal Development Permit is required per Coastal Commission Memorandum dated April 18, 2017. (New Accessory Dwelling Unit Legislation).

The discretionary application required for this project is a Coastal Development Permit (CDP2018-00008) to allow a detached accessory dwelling unit located in the Non-Appealable Jurisdiction of the City's Coastal Zone (SBMC §28.44).

Pursuant to SBMC 28.44.110, when a proposed development only involves the addition of a secondary dwelling unit to an existing single-family residence, the application shall be reviewed by the Staff Hearing Officer without a public hearing in accordance with subdivision (j) of Government Code Section 65852.2. The Staff Hearing Officer shall not issue a decision on the application until at least ten (10) calendar days after notice has been provided. The Staff Hearing Officer may receive and consider written comments from the public, but without a public hearing. The decision will be the final action of the City. The Environmental Analyst has determined that the project is exempt from further environmental review pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15303, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures. Please note that the Staff Hearing Officer may not have time to consider written comments received after 4:30 p.m. on the day before the meeting.

The decision of the Staff Hearing Officer regarding this project will be announced at the regularly scheduled Staff Hearing Officer meeting on Wednesday, July 18, 2018, and shall constitute the final action of the City.

If you, as an aggrieved party or applicant, disagree with the decision of the Staff Hearing Officer regarding the outcome of this application, you may appeal the decision to the Planning Commission. The appeal, accompanied by the appropriate filing fee per application, must be filed at the Planning & Zoning counter at 630 Garden Street within ten calendar days of the Staff Hearing Officer's decision.

If you challenge the permit approval or environmental document in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Staff Hearing Officer at or prior to the public hearing.
