**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The 6,425 square-foot site is currently developed with a one-story single family dwelling with an attached one-car garage. The proposed project involves both a ground floor and second story addition and interior remodel, and a new, attached two-car garage. The proposal also includes a new driveway, a wider curb cut, new doors and windows, a new rear patio, and landscaping. The discretionary application under the jurisdiction of the Staff Hearing Officer required for this project is a Modification to allow a conforming second story addition that will change the basic exterior characteristics of the existing residence that is nonconforming to the required 6' interior setback (SBMC §28.87.030.D and §28.92.110).
