

The City now offers a free personalized internet experience that provides you with knowing city news the moment it is posted, and includes the bookmarking of pages, customization of short cuts (Charm Bar), favorite news feeds, favorite calendars, and of course, subscriptions to what you want to know.

The former “e-subscriptions” has been replaced by “MySB” and has improved in offering you more personalized services.



## How do I get started?

Go to [www.SantaBarbaraCA.gov](http://www.SantaBarbaraCA.gov) and click 'Join' in the **MySB** box on the left hand side of your screen.

You will be taken to the Login screen:






Once you have completed the sign up form, you will be emailed a request to confirm your e-subscription:

## Newsletters & Bulletins

**Board & Commission Recruitments**

Notifications of the City's annual, semi-annual and special recruitments for public service on the City's 32 Advisory Boards, Commissions and Committees. Vacancies on these groups can occur either through scheduled vacancies or as a result of resignations during the year.

**Environmental Review Documents**

Email notification of the electronic posting of Environmental Documents is required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Current Draft Environmental Impact Reports and Draft Mitigated Negative Declarations are noticed in this bulletin for projects to be reviewed by the Planning Commission, Staff Hearing Officer, and City decision-makers.

**Local Coastal Program (LCP)**

The City is updating the 1981 LCP and encourages public involvement. The LCP establishes policies and implementation plans for land development and use in the City's Coastal Zone in conformance with the California Coastal Act. Subscribe here for future public notices.

**Vacation Rentals**
