





I. PURPOSE

- A. This standard establishes color coding system for the management of the tools and equipment of the SBFD.
- B. Identify the station or apparatus that an item is assigned to.

II. COLOR CODING:

- A. Each station or major piece of apparatus will be assigned an exclusive primary color with which to mark its equipment.
- B. Reserve apparatus will be marked with the primary color for that station and Brown, to indicate reserve apparatus.
 1. The color-coding shall be done with colored electrical tape.
 2. It should be applied in a neat and conspicuous manner.
 3. On multiple company operations, the color-coding will facilitate returning equipment to its assigned apparatus.
