I. PROCEDURE

- A. Parking spaces have been designated with a staff number, reserved for secretaries, or marked as Fire Department Parking for employee use. This includes the parking area directly behind Station 1, as well as the “outer” Chapala St. parking area.
- B. Visitors to the fire department may use any open parking space in either area. If no spaces are available, visitors may be directed to the public parking structure in the 900 block of Chapala St.
- C. For security reasons, any personal vehicles parked in the outer parking area should be moved to the inner parking area after 1700 hours. Operations personnel are not to park in any space that is designated by a number or name, in the handicapped parking space, in the annex, or station ramp at any time to include on or off duty, weekends and holidays.
- D. Any personnel that drive personal vehicles to work and utilize a city vehicle will park only their city vehicle in the designated space. Their personal vehicle will be parked in the Chapala parking lot.
- E. When Engine companies are at Station 1 for training or whatever reason, the following parking plan will be in effect:
 - 1. Engine 4 and 2 Park on the rear ramp behind Truck 2
 - 2. Engine 6 and 3 Park on the front ramp in front of Reserve Engine
 - 3. Engine 7 and 5 Park on the rear ramp in front of the Patrol
- F. Obviously, it will not always be practical or possible to park according to the plan due to circumstances, but is expected that parking will be done prudently to affect a smooth exit if necessary and not create a dangerous or congested situation.
- G. Personnel that are not, for whatever reason, parked where they are supposed to be will be asked to immediately move their vehicle to the proper place.
