Chpt: II Hose Lays	Revised: 3/29/13 Pages: 1

Objective: To lay 100' of ¾" hose from the hose reel on the engines; **only to be used for small fires (trash, cans, rubbish and overhaul).**

<u>STEP #</u>	<u>CAPTAIN</u>	<u>ENGINEER</u>	<u>FIREFIGHTER</u>
1	Gives order to Engineer and Firefighter	Receives order from Captain.	Receives order from Captain.
2	Assist firefighter in pulling line and positioning it.	Sets controls in cab and prepares to pump water.	Grasp nozzle and free hose to go to the fire. For corners or obstructions: Make loops of hose at the apparatus, drag in the loops dropping them as needed.
3	Assist in reloading the booster line with rest of crew.	Rewind hose on reel while charged at 50 psi to prevent damage to reel.	Assist in reloading the booster line with the rest of the crew.

Caution: Be careful not to get hands caught in the power reel during reloading. Use a rag or towel to clean the hose as it is loaded. Load the last ten feet by hand. Do not drag the nozzle. Do not overload reel motors when reloading the booster reels.
