About the Santa Barbara Arts and Crafts Show

The Santa Barbara Arts and Crafts Show was established in 1965 by local artists, inspired by the sidewalk art shows of Europe and the prestigious *Jardin del Arte* in Mexico City. Sponsored by the City Parks and Recreation Department since 1966, the show is now the only continuous, non-juried arts festival of original drawings, paintings, graphics, sculpture, crafts, and photography in the world. Whatever the size, subject, media, and price—all are original and made by the artists you meet. Approximately 200 artists display their work in an informal atmosphere that encourages visitors to speak with the artists, and in some cases to see them in action. This show is unique in that each artist lives in Santa Barbara County and personally produces every piece for sale.
