## Municipal Code Section 9.100.90 - Duties of Alarm User.

- A. ALARM USER REPSPONSIBILITIES. An Alarm User shall be responsible for the following:
  - 1. To maintain the Alarm Site and the Alarm System in a manner that will minimize or eliminate False Alarms; and
  - 2. To make every reasonable effort to have a Responder to the Alarm System's location when requested byt the Police Department in order to do the following:
    - a. Deactivate and Alarm System;
    - b. Provide access to the Alarm Site; or
    - c. Provide alternative security for the Alarm Site.
