>> 31 cruise ship visits during mid-week and off-peak months in 2016

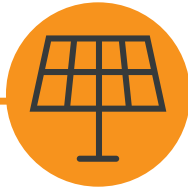
>> \$109 spent per cruise party in Santa Barbara on meals, entertainment, and tours

>> 5.2% Growth in air passengers over previous year

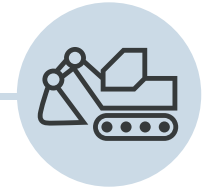
>> \$8 Million - City investment in renovating performing arts theaters



>> 37% Renewable energy powering City facilities



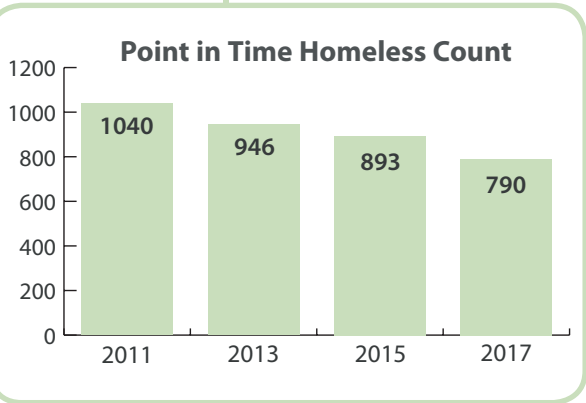
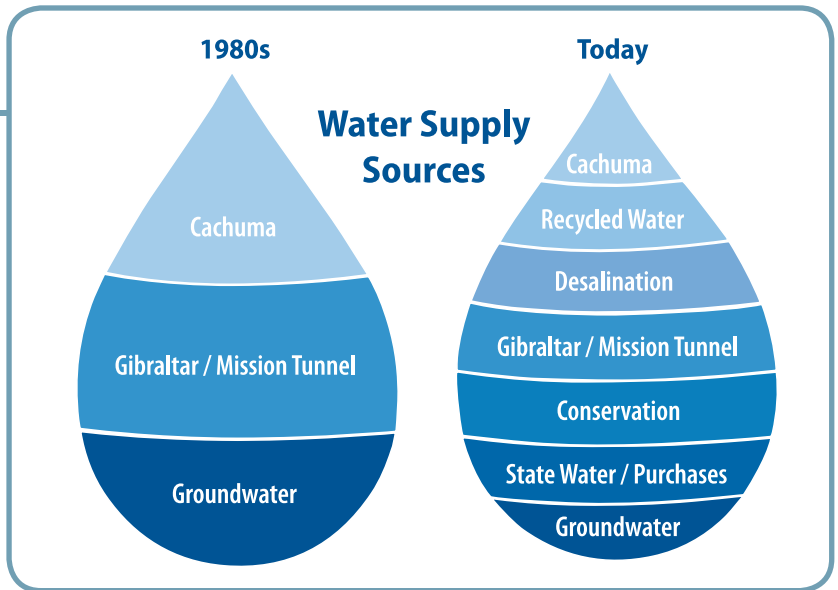
>> 50% City's roads rated as poor, at risk, or failed, before recent rain by independent pavement engineers

>> \$3 Million - City funds spent to address homelessness last year
