Please join the Santa Barbara Parks and Recreation Department, Santa Barbara Trails Council, and Ray Ford for a discussion of the Parma Park trail restoration project and the trail plan prepared over the past year. Project elements include:

- Refurbish existing trails for better water drainage/erosion prevention
- Reroutes or corrections for steep or entrenched trails
- Additional development of user friendly hiking and equestrian trail routes and new destinations
- Protection of environmental resources

The trail restoration project is intended to reduce erosion and increase sustainability, provide a recreationally satisfying and safe trail experience, protect natural and cultural resources and support long-term trail maintenance. The project does not include changes to trail use types. It is primarily intended for hiking and equestrian trails due to the limited access (main road only) for bicycles in Parma Park.
