NOTICE OF VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT PROCESSING AND CANVASSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that I, Sarah Gorman, City Clerk Services Manager of the City of Santa Barbara, do appoint the individuals assigned by the Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to serve as a Processing/Canvassing Board, to process/canvass Vote by Mail ballots and Provisional ballots for the General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2019.

PRE-ELECTION DAY PROCESSING AND CANVASSING *(For Vote by Mail ballots received prior to or on Election Day)*

Pursuant to Elections Code Section 15101(a) the Processing of Vote by Mail ballot return envelopes (verification of signature and address and updating voter records) may begin 29 days before the election, and thus will commence at 8:00 a.m. on October 7, 2019 at the Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk's office; 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, California, 90650. Vote by Mail ballot return envelopes processing may occur daily thereafter between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. To determine if ballot processing will take place on a particular day, please call (805) 564-5309.

Pursuant to Elections Code Section 15101(b) the Pre-Election Canvassing of Vote by Mail ballots (opening the returned vote by mail ballot envelopes, removing the ballots, accurately duplicating any damaged or defective ballots, and preparing the ballots for the ballot count) may begin 10 business days before the election, and thus will commence at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 22, 2019, at Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk's office; 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, California, 90650.

The count of the Vote by Mail ballots (those received on or prior to election day and have been processed and canvassed as described above) will commence at 8:00 p.m. Tuesday, November 5, 2019 at Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk's office; 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, California, 90650.

POST-ELECTION DAY PROCESSING AND CANVASSING *(For Vote by Mail ballots and Provisional ballots received on Election Day and Vote by Mail ballots received up to 3 days following the election)*

The post-election day Processing of Vote by Mail ballot return envelopes and Provisional ballot envelopes (verification of signature and address and updating voter records) will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 6, 2019 at Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk's office; 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, California, 90650. Vote by Mail ballot return envelope and Provisional ballot envelope processing may occur daily thereafter between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. To determine if ballot envelope processing will take place on a particular day, please call (805) 564-5309.

The post-election-day Canvassing of Vote by Mail ballots and Provisional ballots (opening the returned vote by mail ballot envelopes, removing the ballots, accurately duplicating any damaged or defective ballots, and preparing the ballots for the ballot count) will commence 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 6, 2019 at Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk's office; 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, California, 90650.

The post-election day Count of the 2nd batch of Vote by Mail ballots and Provisional ballots will commence at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, November 8, 2019 at 8:00 a.m. at Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk's office; 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, California, 90650.
