



## FY20B Pavement Maintenance Project



*Access Ramp Construction Work on Santa Barbara Street*

Beginning Tuesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, Earthbound Electric in conjunction with Granite Construction Inc. will perform conduit installation work on Santa Barbara Street from Cota Street to Micheltorena Street as part of the FY20B Pavement Maintenance Project. The new underground conduit and wiring ensures reliable traffic signal operations. Most of the existing underground conduit and wiring along Santa Barbara Street is 50 to 60 years old and near the end of its service life.

Detours in the surrounding areas will be in effect to minimize construction duration and disruption to normal traffic flow. Traffic control and temporary delays should be expected along Santa Barbara Street and associated cross-streets. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses, although temporary disruptions should be anticipated, especially while paving activities are taking place.

The schedule for specific road closure/detours on Santa Barbara Street are as follows\*:

- Tuesday – Thursday, November 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>: Santa Barbara at Canon Perdido Street
- Thursday, November 12<sup>th</sup>: Santa Barbara at Cota Street
- Wednesday – Friday, November 18<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup>: Santa Barbara at Carrillo Street
- Tuesday, November 24<sup>th</sup>: Santa Barbara at Carrillo Street
- Wednesday – Friday, December 2<sup>nd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup>: Santa Barbara at Figueroa Street
- Thursday – Friday, December 10<sup>th</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup>: Santa Barbara at Anapamu Street

- Wednesday – Friday, December 16<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup>: Garden at Anapamu Street
- Monday – Wednesday, January 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup>: Santa Barbara at Micheltoarena Street

\*Note: the schedule above is subject to change

No parking signs will be posted at least 72 hours prior to construction and detour signs will also be provided.
