Look for BCycle's electric-assist bikes and docks around town.

Please join the City of Santa Barbara in welcoming our first pilot public bike share system, BCycle! When complete, the system will include 250 electric-assist bikes that riders can check out and return to numerous dock locations throughout the city.

Public bike share programs exist in many cities across the globe. They are an excellent way for locals and visitors alike to get across town, reduce traffic and parking congestion, and minimize carbon emissions. This all-electric fleet will provide a safe, outdoor and socially-distanced transportation option, and allow users to get around for short trips to shop, do errands, commute to work, or explore our beautiful community — all with the added benefit of an electric pedal-assist.
